You can have a **Free Project DAWN (Deaths Avoided with Naloxone)** kit sent to you in the mail. Visit the Tuscarawas County Health Department at www.tchdnow.org/request-a-naloxone-kit.html and complete the following steps to receive your kit by mail*:

1. Watch the Naloxone training video at the website (by requesting a kit, you are certifying that you watched the video in its entirety).
2. Complete the form.
3. Save the form to your Computer.
4. Email the completed form as an attachment to narcan@tchdnow.org . Be sure to include the mailing address that you would like the kit to be mailed to in the body of the email message.
 - Please allow 2-3 business days to process your order.

What is Naloxone (Narcan)?

Naloxone (also known as Narcan) is a medication that can reverse an overdose caused by an opioid drug (heroin, fentanyl, or prescription pain medications). When administered during an overdose, naloxone blocks the effects of opioids on the brain and quickly restores breathing.
