

# Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office Transportation Resources

## FREE Public Transportation

#### Tuscarawas County Job & Family Services (Medicaid Appointments)

If you are a Tuscarawas County resident AND a recipient of Medicaid (health coverage/insurance for eligible low-income adults, children, pregnant women, elderly adults, and people with disabilities) (i.e CareSource, United Healthcare, Molina, Buckeye Health Plan, or Aetna Better Health), you are eligible to receive FREE non-emergency transportation to any Medicaid appointment (in other words, any appointment in which you will be using your Medicaid insurance, you are eligible for this FREE transportation to-and-from that appointment). FREE transportation is also available to a pharmacy for Medicaid-approved prescriptions. You MUST schedule your transportation at least 48 hours before the scheduled appointment time, and no later than 2:30 PM on this day. You must be ready 30 minutes before your scheduled pick-up time. This transportation will be provided by Horizons, SEA, or Access Tusc.

#### Tuscarawas County Senior Center

The Tuscarawas County Senior Center provides safe, door-to-door service throughout the county for residents 60 years of age and older. Transportation may be used for appointments to the doctor, dentist, therapy, hospital, shopping, pharmacy, beauty shop, barber, banking, visiting friends or day-time social events. There is no fee for transportation services but donations are welcome. Transportation is provided 8:15 AM to 3:45 PM Monday through Friday, except for holidays. If you need transportation between 4:30 PM and 7:30 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays or Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM, call the Senior Center to make a reservation at least one day in advance. The cost to go anywhere in Tuscarawas County is \$3.00 one way and \$6.00 round trip. Call to schedule your transportation at least 24 hours before you need the transportation.

## > Tuscarawas County Veterans Service Office (VA)

The VA provides free transportation for veterans to the VA medical facilities of Wade Park, Parma, Canton and Akron. You must call and schedule your transportation at least 48 hours before your scheduled appointment time. You must bring your appointment letter to board the van. The transportation to your appointment will depart from the Tuscarawas County Veterans Service Office (VA), 393 16th St. SW New Philadelphia, OH 44663. **WADE PARK:** Medical appointments should be made after 8:30 AM and before 2:30 PM Monday – Friday. Your transportation is scheduled to leave promptly at 5:30 AM. **PARMA**: Medical appointments should be made after 9:00 AM and before 1:00 PM Monday – Friday. Your transportation is scheduled to leave promptly at 5:30 AM. **CANTON/AKRON:** Medical appointments should be made after 8:30 AM and before 2:00 PM Monday – Friday. Transportation to these facilities are on an as needed basis.

## AT A FEE Public Transportation

#### Access Tusc Transit

Public transportation is available both in Tuscarawas county as well as out-of-county. Transportation anywhere in Tuscarawas county is \$4 one way \$8 round-trip, one way in Dover/New Philadelphia city limits is \$3.00 and round-trip is \$6.00. Transportation out-of-county ranges from \$20 to \$60 one-way. You must call and schedule transportation at least 48 business hours in advance. Transportation is available Monday through Friday from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM and Saturdays from 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM. There is no transportation service on Sundays.

## Horizons of Tuscarawas & Carroll Counties

Transportation is available for many purposes - doctor's office, hospital, treatments, school, employment, shopping, recreation, and other purposes. Pickup can be arranged at any location in Tuscarawas County, and transportation may be requested to and from any location in the county. If you have special requirements, mention them when making a reservation. You must call and schedule transportation at least 48 hours in advance. This transportation is available from anywhere in Tuscarawas County to anywhere in Tuscarawas County. Fees range from \$10-16.

## Society for Equal Access (SEA)

Transportation is available for both in Tuscarawas county and outside of Tuscarawas County. This transportation is open for everyone. Fees include: round-trip within New Philadelphia and Dover limits is \$20, anywhere outside of New Philadelphia and Dover limits is \$2 per mile. You will need to schedule transportation at least 48 hours in advance. If you are unable to afford the fees of SEA transportation, you can contact "*Provide-A-Ride*" to set-up financial assistance **first** and then call SEA to schedule.
