➤ **Women, Infants, & Children (WIC)**

WIC is a program in which you apply and, if accepted, you receive a WIC card. The WIC program is available to low to moderate income pregnant women, recently delivered women, breastfeeding women, infants, and children up to age 5 who are at nutrition risk. Fathers can also bring their children to apply for WIC. You may apply for WIC if you are working or unemployed.
