Employment Opening Behavioral Health Clinician



The re-entry program at the Tuscarawas County Jail is looking for a full-time Behavioral Health Clinician. The re-entry program is designed to provide resources and treatment options to individuals who are incarcerated in the county jail, to promote their successful re-entry back into the community, and ultimately provide them support to not return to incarceration. Currently, the re-entry program is made up of the Re-Entry Coordinator. The Tuscarawas County Jail is looking to expand the re-entry program with the addition of a Behavioral Health Clinician to provide needed mental health and substance use services to the inmate population, and expand re-entry programming with the addition of group treatment options.

Work Hours:

Monday – Friday, 8:00am – 4:00pm (40 hours) Job Duties:

- Provide therapeutic services to the inmate population
- Screen and assess inmates for psycho-social issues, as well as mental health and substance use disorders
- Provide inmates education about mental health and substance use disorders and available treatment options, including medication management
- Conduct behavioral health assessments per court order or recommendation via re-entry and/or medical staff
- Provide mental health and substance use counseling/therapy, including brief interventions using evidence-based techniques
- Facilitate evidence-based group treatment, including mental health group therapy, anger management group therapy, and substance use group therapy
- Deliver therapeutic crisis intervention, as needed
- Speak with inmates on the 10-minute suicide watch to create safety plans, as necessary
- Refer inmates to outpatient agencies, as appropriate
- Perform clinical documentation and create treatment plans for inmates, as appropriate
- Coordinate alongside the Re-Entry Coordinator and medical staff to ensure proper course of treatment and needs for the inmate population
- Additional duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or higher in the field of social work, psychology, counseling, or a related field
- Must hold one of the following licensures: LSW, LPC, LISW, or LPCC
- Must be licensed with the Ohio Chemical Dependency Professionals Board as a LCDC III or LICDC
- Must have at least 2 years of experience in the field of mental health and substance use
- Must have an interest working with the incarcerated adult (18+) population
- Applicant is subject to a background check and fingerprinting
