Two Charged with Felonious Assault

Wyatt Andrew Shaw, 20, of Gnadenhutten and Landon Scott Levengood, 19, of Sherrodsville have been indicted by the Tuscarawas County Grand Jury on a charge of Felonious Assault, a felony of the second degree.

These charges are a result of a road rage incident which turned violent.

On Friday, February 9, 2024, the Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office was contacted by Cleveland Clinic Union Hospital regarding an individual who arrived at the Emergency Room to seek treatment as a result of being assaulted following what was described to be a road rage incident.

The victim, 53-year-old, New Philadelphia resident, described that while traveling westbound on West High Avenue he was "cut off" by another driver operating a white Chevrolet pickup as he proceeded southbound on 16th Street SW. The victim blew his vehicle's horn and flashed his headlights at the offending driver to express his displeasure. The combination of actions escalated and the driver of the white truck followed the victim to an area near his home where he pulled over.

A physical altercation took place resulting in the victim being punched and kicked repeatedly before the suspects fled the area. There was said to be three suspects who were occupants of the truck and involved in the assault. The victim sustained significant injury to his face and has undergone multiple surgeries to repair the damage.

Upon investigation, two individuals were identified as primary aggressors in the assault. Both Wyatt Shaw and Landon Levengood have been summoned to appear at the Tuscarawas County Common Pleas Court on Wednesday, June 26, 2024 at 1:00 pm.
