Discussion: David Haverfield, Director of Job & Family Services (JFS) presented a resolution for the hiring of personnel in the JFS Office. Mr. Haverfield would like Autumn Hodkinson to join the office. Commissioner Metzger asked what the reasons are for the many recent vacancies at JFS and if exit interviews are conducted. Mr. Haverfield confirmed exit interviews are conducted and added one employee returned to a different department and some positions were not filled due to COVID-19, but now things are starting to get back to normal, and the positions need to be filled.

RESOLUTION (118-2022) PERSONNEL ACTION – JFS (Hodkinson)

It was moved by Commissioner Landis, seconded by Commissioner Metzger, to approve the personnel action hiring of Autumn Hodkinson as an Income Maintenance Worker 3 at Tuscarawas County Job & Family Services as recommended by David Haverfield, Director. Autumn Hodkinson would fill a vacant position, effective February 14, 2022. Mr. Haverfield has concluded an independent assessment to determine that this applicant meets the minimum qualifications for this position

Discussion: Jesse Rothacher, Park Manager, was present to talk about applying for the OMEGA RTPO grant. This grant would assist with covering the cost of the engineering design and construction of the extension of the towpath trail (Kimble Trail). There have been other funds raised for both construction and engineering and design fund. The Tuscarawas County Park Department would be covered in the event the Friends of Tuscarawas County Parks does not receive their grant request from the Rosenberry Foundation. However, if the Friends of Tuscarawas County Parks are awarded those monies, the Park Department would not have to allocate as much of those funds towards the engineering design and would be able to allocate the remainder into the construction phase.

Commissioner Landis stated he had a casual meeting with Secretary of State, Frank LaRose on Monday, and Mr. LaRose was telling Mr. Landis how he and his family ride the trails. Mr. LaRose asked about the progress of the trails here in Tuscarawas County. Mr. Landis advised the trails are a priority. Mr. LaRose stated people come from all over to ride the trails in Tuscarawas County and was very complimentary on what has been completed so far.

Mr. Rothacher stated the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail stops at the Zoarville Station Bridge in Fairfield Township right now, but will start back up from Old Zoarville Road and continue to the Dover Dam. This part of the trail would be between the Tuscarawas River and Camp Tuscazoar and other properties on the other side. From the Dover Dam, there is an access road the Army Corp of Engineers put in, and will take you south to SR 416 near White Bridge.

RESOLUTION (119-2022) 2022 OMEGA RTPO ALLOCATION PROGRAM APPLICATION AUTHORIZATION

It was moved by Commissioner Metzger, and seconded by Commissioner Landis, to authorize the Tuscarawas County Park Department to apply for the 2022 Ohio Mid-Eastern Governments Association (OMEGA) Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) Capital Allocation Program for the amount of \$100,000 to help with engineering, design, and construction of the Towpath Trail extension ("Kimble Trail").

The 2022 OMEGA RTPO application does not have a minimum required local match.

Discussion: Jesse Rothacher, Park Manager, was present to request the Commissioners to enter into a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with MS Consultants. Entering into this agreement with MS Consultants would secure the TAP Grant to make sure the schedule stays on course to maintain eligibility for the construction monies. Commissioner Metzger thanked Mr. Rothacher for all of his hard work and looking into so many other funding mechanisms.

RESOLUTION (120-2022) PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH MS CONSULTANTS FOR TOWPATH TRAIL DEVELOPMENT

It was moved by Commissioner Landis, and seconded by Commissioner Metzger, to enter into a professional service agreement with ms consultants, Inc. for the engineering and design of a two-mile extension of the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail from Old Zoarville Rd. to the Dover Dam in Fairfield Township for a total cost of \$118,388. Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Bob Stephenson II has approved the agreement as to form.

The Tuscarawas County Park Department was awarded a \$483,000 ODOT TAP grant for this project's construction phase. The Friends of Tuscarawas County Parks, through private donations and grants awarded by the Timken Foundation and the Haman Family Foundation, raised \$65,000 to cover the ODOT TAP local match and anticipated construction costs over the TAP award.

The Tuscarawas County Park Department was awarded \$10,000 from the Ohio & Erie Canalway Association (OECA) for the engineering and design costs, and is seeking an additional \$12,500. The Friends of Tuscarawas County Parks submitted a request of \$25,000 from the Rosenberry Foundation to help with the engineering and design costs as well.

The Tuscarawas County Park Department is also seeking \$100,000 from the 2022 OMEGA RTPO program for engineering, design, and construction costs.
