Floodplain Development Permit Tuscarawas SWCD revised: 16 June 2022 (lcf)

DISCUSSION: Lee Finley, Flood Plain Coordinator, wanted to add he is still going back and forth with the attorney on the Wallick Enforcement issue. If there is no resolution soon, Mr. Finley is going to forward the issue on to the Prosecutor's Office.

There was a permit just approved for HWY 39. The land owner was given permission to do some work in the Flood Plain, and was to stay away from the Flood Way, but ended up putting all of the top soil he dug up in the Flood Way. Mr. Finley is in the process of getting that taken back off.

DISCUSSION: Deputy Chris Edwards stated he is proud of the service Bruno provided for the County. Deputy Bruno kept capital offenders off of the streets and found a lot of dangerous people. Commissioner Ress stated it sounds like he has been a wonderful dog. The Commissioners thanked Deputy Bruno and Deputy Edwards for all they have done together over the years for Tuscarawas County.
