

# **RESOLUTION (699-2023) ADDENDUM TO COMMUNITY-BASED CORRECTIONS SUBSIDY GRANT AGREEMENT**

It was moved by Commissioner Ress, seconded by Commissioner Zemis to approve the addendum to the Community-Based Corrections Subsidy Grant Agreement. The Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC), and Tuscarawas County Court of Common Pleas Adult Probation Department increased the award of the CCA 2.0 grant from \$258,408.00 to \$271,328.00 and the PSG grant from \$300,000.00 to \$368,359.00, not to exceed \$1,184,075.00 for the FY 2024/2025.
