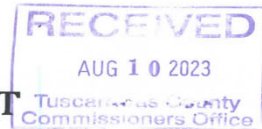

RESOLUTION (699-2023) ADDENDUM TO COMMUNITY-BASED CORRECTIONS SUBSIDY GRANT AGREEMENT

It was moved by Commissioner Ress, seconded by Commissioner Zemis to approve the addendum to the Community-Based Corrections Subsidy Grant Agreement. DISCUSSION: *Richelle Lefler, TuscBDD Special Olympics Coordinator, informed the Commissioners that Special Olympics is a year-round sports program. This year, the Tuscarawas County Special Olympics competed in five sports; Bocce, bowling, volleyball, track and power-lifting. The athletes brought home 27 gold medals, 11 silver and 8 bronze medals! This year 60 athletes competed. The athletes and coaches represented Tuscarawas County so well.
