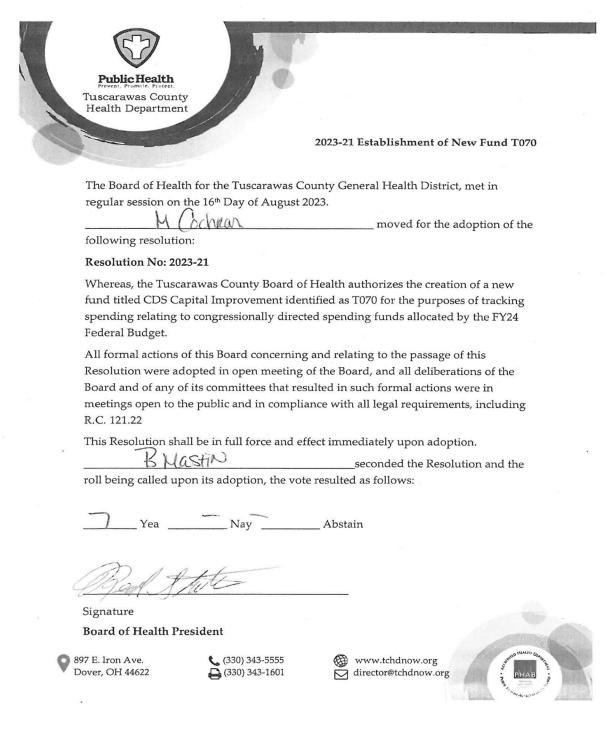

Tuscarawas County Health Department requested the federal funding in order to secure its facilities, increase handicap accessibility, and renovating and updating its facilities.

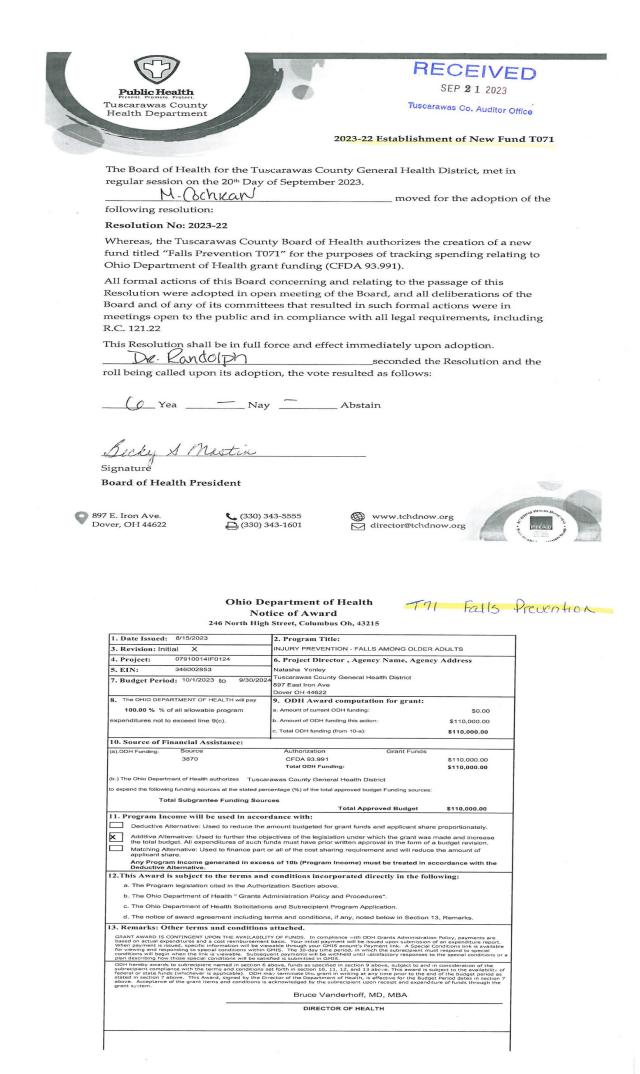

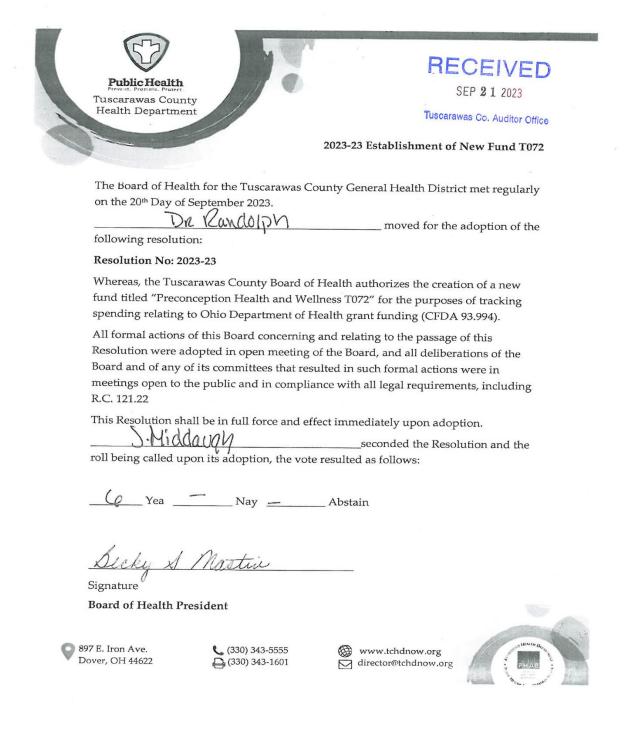

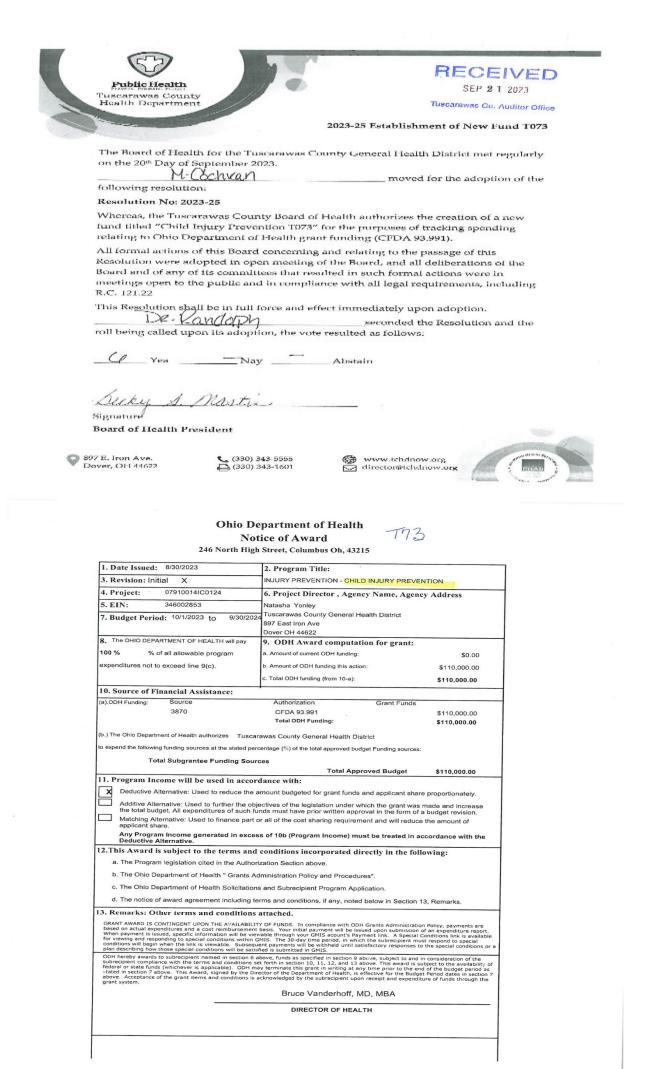
