Ohio Pet Fund Grant Agreement

The grant to your organization from the Ohio Pet Fund is for the purpose described below and is subject to your organization's acceptance of the terms and conditions herein. Grant money may be used only for sterilization programs unless other permission is received in writing. Grantee will spend the grant funds for sterilization described in its grant application subject to the following conditions and requirements.

Conditions of Grant:

Grantee represents and warrants that it will administer the grant and is an organization eligible to receive funding as (a) an animal shelter as defined in section 4729.01 of the Revised Code, a facility operated by a humane society or any society organized under Chapter 1717 of the Revised Code, or a dog pound operated pursuant to Chapter 955 of the Revised Code, (b) a local nonprofit veterinary association that operates a program for the sterilization of dogs and cats; or (c) a charitable organization that is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Grantee Further Agrees:

-That the grant monies must be spent for the purposes stated in this grant agreement and within one year of funding; to repay to the Ohio Pet Fund upon demand the full amount of the grants funds if there is a failure to comply with any provision of the this grant agreement; and to repay any portion of the grant funds not used within one year of funding unless an extension is granted in writing by the Ohio Pet Fund.

-To submit a Grant Utilization Report to the Ohio Pet Fund within one year of receiving the funds, and to submit interim reports during the year if requested by the Ohio Pet Fund.

-To keep adequate records of expenditures and to enable such records to be readily reviewed by the Ohio Pet Fund or by anyone authorized by the Ohio Pet Fund to review such records.

-To notify the Ohio Pet Fund if any changes occur which could lead to a change in the Grantee's eligibility for funding under Ohio Revised Code Section 955.201(B)(1), and to notify the Ohio Pet Fund if any changes occur in the program or project for which funding is given, as specifically set out in the purposes and conditions of the grant agreement.

Grantee shall require that the individuals who request that their dogs and cats be spayed or neutered with money provided by this grant present one of the following pieces of documentary evidence in the name of the owner or any member of the owner's family who resides with the owner:

- 1. Section 8 housing voucher
2. Schedule letter from Ohio Works First
3. Ohio Medicaid card
4. Letter from Veteran Benefits Administration acknowledging service-related disability
5. Ohio Direction Card (or proof of financial qualification for food stamps)
6. WIC card (or proof of financial qualification for Women Infants and Children nutrition program)
7. Benefit letter documenting Supplemental Security Income
8. Benefit letter documenting assistance from Social Security Disability
9. Certificate of adoption showing that the animal was adopted from a licensed animal shelter or pound.
10. Certificate of adoption showing that the animal was adopted from a nonprofit corporation.
11. Tax return showing owner's family income does not exceed 150% of the federal poverty guideline established by the United States Department of Health and Human Services
12. Evidence that the owner or pet otherwise qualify via Sec. 955.201(C)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code

Records of expenditures for sterilization shall include the name of the pet's owner and the type of documentary evidence provided (number 1-12 above). Do not send the records unless we ask for them for audit purposes. In most cases, we will only need the Grant Utilization form, due within a year of receipt of grant funds. Un-owned dogs and cats that are awaiting release from non-profit organizations, humane societies, shelters, and pounds are also eligible for the use of grant funds for sterilization.

The terms and conditions of this grant agreement have been read, are understood and are accepted. **DISCUSSION: ANGELA SIMMERMAN RECOGNITION:** *Angela Simmerman, Family Nurse Practitioner, Trinity Health System, was present to talk about being awarded the Senatorial commendation. Mrs. Simmerman started by saying she is very excited that the work she is doing is getting noticed. The Health Department contacted Mrs. Simmerman last year to see if her office could get some numbers for them involving underage nicotine and/or vaping statistics in Southern Tuscarawas County so they could put together a grant for some money to help with the nicotine and vaping problem.*

*Mrs. Simmerman stated she had a thirteen-year-old child that had been vaping for approximately six months and had no past medical history. This child came in for rhino virus (common cold) and was put on a ventilator for 5 days. The only risk factor she had was that she had been vaping for about six months.*

*Another case was a patient who went into a state of psychosis and had to be institutionalized. She was vaping marijuana. Doctors were not sure if it was the levels of marijuana because she had been smoking marijuana for years. It was thought to be because of the vape. It was determined that this patient had an underlying issue and she could not metabolize copper. She had a copper accumulation that sent her that sent her into psychosis. This has been quite an eye-opening experience. I am very honest and up-front with the kids and let them know what they need to know. I have told these kids they are going to be the generation walking around with oxygen tanks at 30 – 40 years old. We do not know the full effect of what vaping does to the body yet.*

*Nicotine levels in a vape are much higher than in a cigarette. Some of the vape pods can be equivalent to three packs of cigarettes. The risk of addiction for a teenager is so much higher because the brain is not fully developed until the age of 25.*

*Mrs. Simmerman is going out on her own and opening her own practice so she can do more in the community. She knows what needs to be done and she wants to get the ball rolling on getting it done. She feels she can make the biggest difference with pediatrics. They do listen to her and she is teaching her and their parents.*
