#### III. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Tuscarawas County will assist the City of Uhrichsville and the Village of Dennison in replacing 2,543 linear feet of waterline with 12" HDPE pipe on East First Street in Uhrichsville; the water main serves all residents in the bordering municipalities. Additional water facilities improvements include installation of four (4) fire hydrants, 15 water valves, and 181 linear feet of 6-inch waterline. Repeated shutdowns of the existing 100-year-old cast iron waterline cause service disruptions to all residents in the combined service area. In addition, the County will repair/replace 2,469 linear feet of streets and 360 linear feet of sidewalks once the water facilities improvements are complete. A total of 7,995 people will benefit from the project, 61.23 percent of which are low- and moderate-income. The total project cost is \$912,000, and the Twin City Water and Sewer District will contribute \$412,000 in matching funds.

Tuscarawas County is moving funds between projects to allow for the completion of a final performance report that correctly lists project expenditures
