RESOLUTION (220-2024) – AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY - STONE CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

It was moved by Commissioner Abbuhl, and seconded by Commissioner Ress to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, Tuscarawas County, Ohio owns and operates the Tuscarawas County Metropolitan Sewer District in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6117; and

WHEREAS, the existing Stone Creek wastewater treatment plant located at 106 North St, Stone Creek, OH 43840 requires replacement to meet current and future wastewater treatment needs; and

WHEREAS, the County entered into a real estate purchase agreement on September 13, 2023 with Quillin Dairy Farm, Ltd. for the purchase of a 0.39 acre split from the southern portion of Tuscarawas County Parcel #30-00345-000, adjacent to the existing Stone Creek wastewater treatment plant, for the purpose of constructing a new wastewater treatment plant to replace the existing wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the real estate purchase agreement was contingent upon satisfactory results from a geotechnical investigation conducted by the County; and

WHEREAS, the geotechnical investigation has been completed and the results are satisfactory for the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to exercise its authority under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6117.39 to acquire the Property for the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Tuscarawas County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. Purchase of Property. The purchase of a 0.39 acre split from the southern portion of Tuscarawas County Parcel #30-00345-000 from Quillin Dairy Farm, Ltd., pursuant to the real estate purchase agreement dated September 13, 2023, is hereby approved.

Section 2. Purchase Price. The purchase price for the property shall be \$18,000.00 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the real estate purchase agreement.

Section 3. Closing and Documents. The President and/or Vice-President of the Board is hereby authorized to conduct the closing for the purchase of the property and to sign all necessary documents to complete the transfer of title to the County.

Section 4. Funding. The purchase price for the property shall be funded from the Sewer District Fund.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 6. Meeting Open to the Public. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution and any referenced attachments have been reviewed and found in proper order by Steven A. Anderson, Special Counsel.
